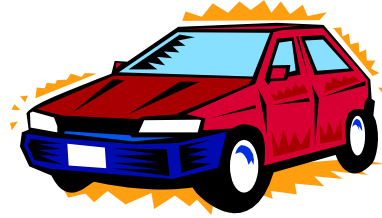

TO: Parents of Senior Students

RE: Parking Permits



This is our parking contract for you and your student to sign before receiving a parking permit for the 2009/2010 school year. Please read through it carefully with your student.

PARKING PERMITS:

Seniors are the only students allowed to purchase parking permits. Permits may be purchased for \$300.00 at the book sale or the bookstore.

Please know that all students must complete the "Alive at 25" course prior to being allowed to park on campus. A record of course completion needs to be brought to the Deans' office so that we can then process your parking registration.

A parking sticker will be applied to the car by a security guard after presenting the receipt of payment, driver's license, school ID, vehicle registration and this contract signed by both student and parent. Students should plan to bring the car they will be driving to the East Entrance (back of school) during the book sale. Students that miss this registration period must make arrangements with the Deans' Office to complete the application process.

SCHOOL PARKING RULES AND PROCEDURES:

1. Authorized student drivers are required to obtain and display a school parking permit as directed.
2. Student parking is not allowed in designated visitor or staff parking areas.
3. Students cannot re-enter the parking lot on the same day without administrative approval after leaving the parking lot before completion of their school day.
4. Students are not permitted to sit in parked cars during any part of the school day.
5. Motorcycles and motor bikes must be parked in designated parking areas.
6. There is a charge for parking permits or replacement permits. All permits will be applied to the vehicle by a Security Officer. Any unauthorized transfer of a parking permit will render it invalid, and the vehicle will be considered illegally parked.
7. All automobiles parked on school grounds must be registered with the school and current decal must be displayed on the automobile as determined by the Deans' Office.
8. All students must be licensed and covered by insurance. The school is not responsible for the automobile or its contents while being parked on campus.
9. For the safety of all, speeding (driving over 5 miles per hour) is not tolerated.
10. Students must follow the directions of the security guard in the parking lot at all times.

LOSS OF PARKING PRIVILEGES:

Student parking privileges will be suspended and/or revoked for 1) any non-school related incident involving alcohol, tobacco, and/or drugs as determined by school personnel and/or reported by the police, 2) any violation of District Alcohol, Tobacco, and other Drugs policy. The principal or principal's designee will notify legal authorities of all evidence and reports of all illegal activity if warranted. Student parking privileges may also be suspended and/or revoked for any violations of the parking policy or student discipline policy.

VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH:

Vehicles are subject to search by school officials for any reason. Searches may include all vehicle compartments and all containers therein of any kind, whether locked or unlocked.

Students parking on campus without authorization and without a valid parking permit appropriately displayed on their car will receive consequences to include, but not limited to, Saturday detention, in-school suspension, loss of parking privileges and towing of vehicle.

Students must report to the Deans' Office immediately if you 1) receive notice of a parking violation, 2) lose your permit, 3) need to retrieve something from your vehicle during the school day (i.e., 7:22 a.m. – 3:14 p.m.), 4) are driving a different vehicle than the one registered with the Deans' Office.
